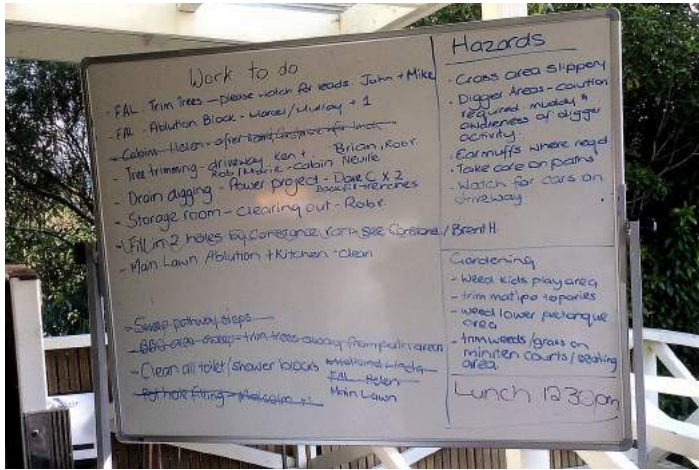

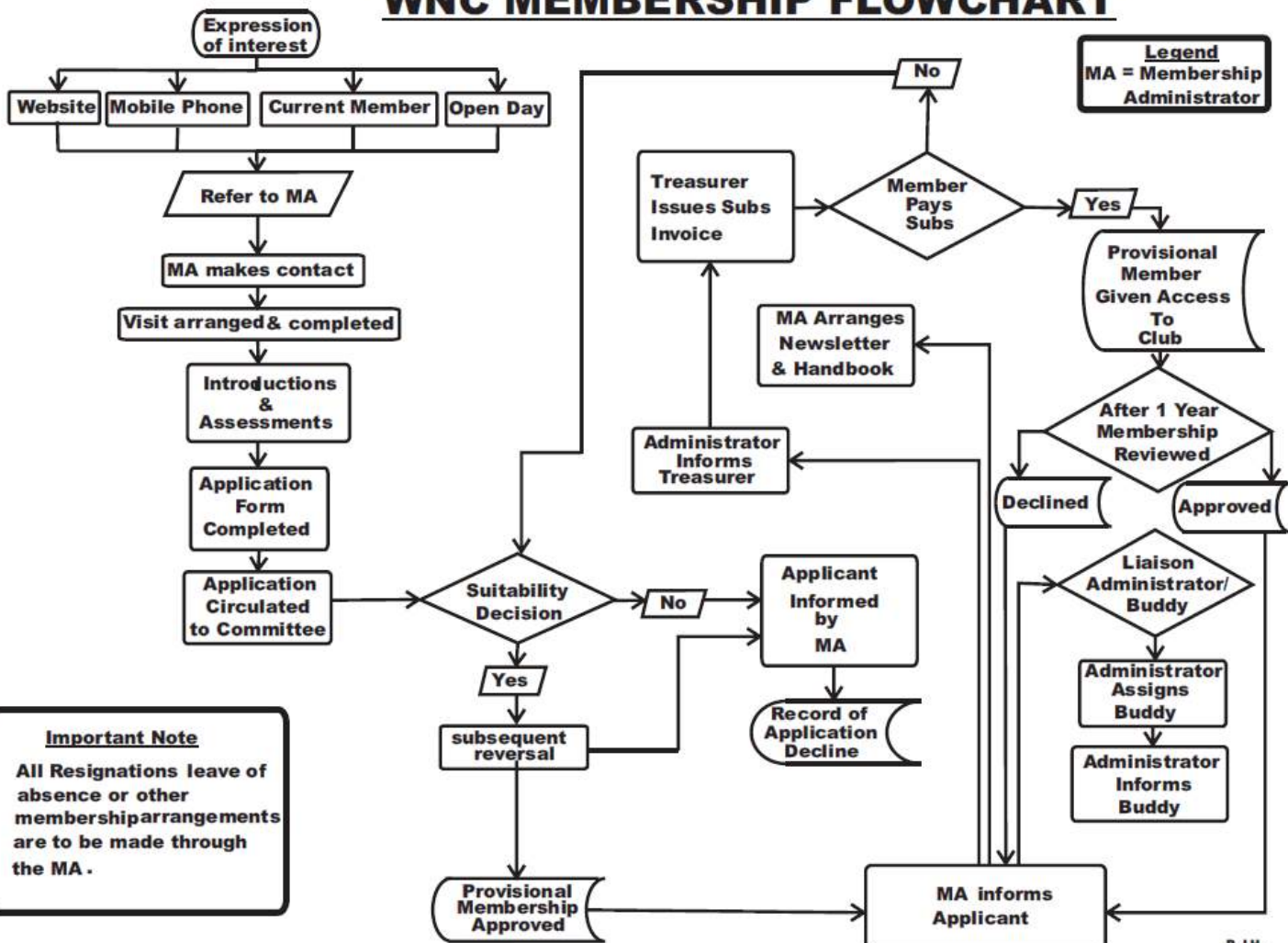
Financial leakage
