HASH HOUSE HARRIERS



On Tuesday 13th February the Port Nicholson Geriatrics Hash House Harriers will again be meeting on the club's grounds. This will be the tenth time the group has run from the club's grounds. The event has been successful in both raising the club's profile & also providing an interesting venue for the harriers. I've had several of the harriers asking me when we would be doing another run from Te Marua.

For those not aware of the previous runs, the Port Nicholson Geriatrics Hash House Harriers are a group of social runners & walkers. This group is a mix of approximately 50% men & 50% woman, with ages varying from 30's to 70's, of generally out-going people who enjoy exercising & socialising. They run or walk from a different venue around the Wellington area each Tuesday evening. We usually get about 30 harriers along each week.

The harriers will be meeting at the club at 6:30pm to head off for either an approximately 8k run or 5k walk. Afterwards they will be returning to the club for a meal (being provided by the club), drinks & socialising. They will congregate on the main lawn (or hall depending on the weather) & will be encouraged to use the pool, spa or sauna (observing club rules).

Club members are of course welcome to use their facilities as normal & are invited to join us for some exercise and/or socialising. Wayne is doing the catering for the night & club members are welcome to join in for the meal at a cost of \$8-00. The club will be running a cash bar on the night.

On the night the gate will be open from 6pm to 10pm to enable the harriers to come & go, please leave it open during this time.
