Charging of electric vehicles at our club

The Committee has discussed this issue at length and our electrician has provided the following regulations that our club comes under.

Our club comes under **mode 1** charging according to AS/ NZS 3000:2018

Clause 7.9.2.1 Source of supply

The supply **shall not be obtained** from a switchboard in an outbuilding that has a separate MEN earthing system. (our club).

Clause 7.9.2.2 Socket outlets for mode 1 charging. Socket outlets **shall not be installed** for use in mode 1 charging. (our club).

So to summarise, electric vehicles **cannot** be charged at our club.

Notices will be installed on all power outlets.

Work completed

- 1. New cable for Lowlands is now connected and power points operational.
- 2. Site in Faraway Land corner levelled ready for grassing.
- Footbridge from visitor parking to lower dell including path way through dell, finished. Planting and work under bridge to allow flood flows also done.
- 4. Triangle at the entrance now filled making it much easier for large vehicles to turn around.
- 5. Dishwasher in the catering kitchen fixed under warranty.
- 6. BBQ wood storage erected.

Work ongoing or to be done

 Leaking roof in Cabins 3 and 4 has left stains which our plasterer is fixing.

- 2. Visitor parking areas by stream almost complete, area to be grassed and signage erected soon.
- 3. June's new pool garden needs boxing up then concrete will be organised.
- 4. New rotary clothes line to be installed in FAL.
- 5. Fence on bottom field has been shortened and will be re-erected at right angles.
- 6. The fan in the spa room has blown up so we are sourcing a replacement.
- 7. Water pipeline to Park lane needs replacing.
- 8. Cabins 1 & 2 upgrades almost complete.
- 9. Work on FAL ablution block is continuing.
- 10. Tree trimming piles on golf course to be burnt, maybe during the next school holidays.
- 11. Need to consider redoing drive up to FAL as big vehicles are sliding off concrete tracks.

Links to the Poster, programme and registration form are in the covering email. Information can also be found on the club notice board.


