At the moment we are in Level 2 lockdown. This means that we are open almost as normal but we should sign in using the QR contact tracing app, use the booking system for the spa and sauna, continue to practice good hygiene, maintain physical distancing from people outside your bubble or wear a mask if you have any concerns about underlying health conditions. But more importantly, if you are unwell or feel unsafe, stay home.

In the event that Wellington moves to Level 3 all members will be advised on how it affects them visiting the club.

I trust this helps to allay any of your concerns and that the club will continue to provide a refuge for people to recharge and forget about the worries of the world.




Southern Naturally Naturist Club
