


President's Piece

Percy Cousins Trust (PCT)

The PCT will be holding their annual face to face meeting at our club on 20 August.

The PCT was set up in 1961 as a permanent memorial to what Percy Cousins had done for the nudist movement not only in New Zealand but also in building up goodwill with other national nudist associations overseas. From this basis the Trust has grown to be a respected organisation, legally established and run.

The PCT provides loans to clubs at a cheaper rate than most other organisations. There are four trustees: Noel Thomas (Pineglades), June Campbell-Tong (WNC), Donna Miller (AONC) and Ken Mercer (WNC).

Funds are raised by interest on loans, interest on invested funds, donations and festival collections - we will be holding an auction as part of the Variety Show.

All members of WNC are welcome to be on site and continue to make use of our normal facilities, pool, BBQ bar and BYO BBQ etc, during festival week but if you have not registered for the festival you will not be able to take part in any of the festival activities, sports, morning and afternoon teas and the evening functions etc. There will be options to pay for single day/evening festival function attendance provided in the September newsletter for people who do not wish, or are unable to attend the entire festival.
